It features unique qualities including flecked patterns in quartersawn sections, a coarse texture with straight but interlocking grain, and distinctive silver grain markings from its medullary rays. Known for its strength and durability, it's valued across many applications.



WALNUT

Walnut is a premium hardwood characterised by its dark, dense and tight-grained structure. Its colour transitions from creamy white sapwood to dark chocolate heartwood, developing a beautiful patina over time.

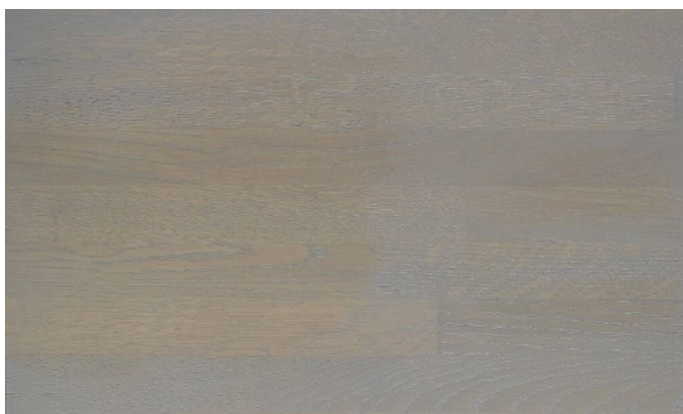

Bespoke or Oiled Solid Wood Worksurfaces are supplied boxed in Cardboard as standard.

All of our Bespoke Tops are finished with 2 coats of Osmo Top Oil, which is based on natural Vegetable oils and waxes and is entirely safe for use in food areas once dry.

Full Bespoke shapes and sizes are available up to 1290mm wide.

It is important that tops are stored flat and in conditions similar to where the top will be fitted.



Disclaimer: Unless specified otherwise, all worksurfaces and upstands are provided unfinished. Keep in mind that the type of oil you select will influence the final finish. Additionally, please note that the colours depicted in this brochure may differ slightly from the actual product due to variations in photography and printing.

INSTALLATION, CARE & MAINTENANCE

Solid wood worksurfaces are easy to care for with minimal upkeep. Apply our recommended oil to preserve the surface's water-resistant and durable qualities, while also enhancing the wood's natural beauty through a gradual darkening process.

Comprehensive installation, care, and maintenance instructions are included in the 'Installation Kit.' Proper installation is key to the performance of your Tuscany worksurface, so please ensure all instructions are followed carefully.

Here are some useful tips for keeping your worksurface in great condition:

- Always use a chopping board when preparing food—avoid cutting directly on the surface
- Hot pans, rough-bottomed items, and wet objects should never be placed directly on the worksurface. Always use pan stands or trivets
- Immediately wipe up water spills or other liquids—do not let them sit on the surface
- To clean the wood, simply wipe with a damp cloth using warm water and a small amount of washing-up liquid
- Regularly re-oil the surface and edges to maintain their finish and durability



Caring for a timber worksurface is simpler than you might expect. Once installed, it should be treated with several coats of oil.

After that, just occasional light sanding and re-oiling is all that's required. The oil nourishes the wood, allowing it to age beautifully while also helping to protect it from stains and spills.

It's a low-maintenance, hygienic surface—perfect for any kitchen. Our striking End Grain Butcher Block offers a contemporary twist on classic oak, making it an ideal choice for an island unit in a mixed-material kitchen.
